

Temple Policy for offering Garlands

1. The Temple will accept fresh flower garlands from devotees on all days except designated Temple event days, as listed in the calendar. If garlands are received on these reserved days, they may be used the following day or for decorating Baba padukas and other areas on the same day.
2. Garlands may be adorned/changed a maximum of two times per day, once in the morning (after Kakad aarti) and once in the evening (before Dhoop Aarti) if more than one garland is received from devotees.
3. Garlands will be accepted on first come first served basis and should be received on the prior day.
4. If more than two garlands are received, the additional garlands will be used on subsequent days or for decorating other Stanas.
5. Garlands made with Tinted flowers, Dyed or Spray-painted flowers, plastic, wool, artificial materials or other materials will not be accepted.
6. The Temple reserves the discretion to reject any garland if the flowers are spoiled, have an unpleasant smell, or are of poor quality.

Sizes of the garlands:

- Altar/Main Baba: 45 inches length and 9 inches tassels, Diameter 2.5 to 3 inches
- Gurusthan Baba: 27 inches length and 5 inches tassels, Diameter 2 to 2.5 inches

Temple Policy for offering Baba's Dresses

1. The Temple will provide Baba's dresses on all designated Temple event days, as listed in the calendar; dresses from devotees will not be accepted on these days.
2. Dresses from devotees will be accepted on days other than designated event days.
3. Devotees should hand over dresses to the priest on duty and reserve the date and provide name and contact number. Dress reservations will not be accepted through phone.
4. Dresses from devotees will be accepted and date reserved up to a maximum of 90 days in advance
5. The date shall be reserved at the time the dress is handed over to the Temple. Only dresses that are properly stitched and have finished edges will be accepted.
6. Sarees and other loose or unstitched dress materials will not be accepted.
7. While the Temple respects the sentiments of devotees and makes its best efforts to use the garments offered, however, Temple reserves the right not to use them if they are not of appropriate size or color, etc.
8. The color of the dress must comply with the color code provided below.

Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday	Saturday	Sunday
Purple	Red	Green	Orange	White	Blue	Gold

9. The size of the dress must comply with the measurements listed below.

Measurements:

Dress item	Main Baba	Gurusthan Baba
Baba's Dress	3 ½ yards (standard width)	2 yards (standard width)
Baba's Angavastram	2 yards (standard width)	1 ½ yards (standard width)

10. There is no reservation policy for Gurusthan Baba dresses. However, the Temple accepts dresses from devotees and will use the donated dresses as and when required, at the Temple's discretion

11. Any dress donated to the Temple becomes Temple property and will not be returned
12. Even if the dress is accepted by Priests on Temple event days and it will be not used by Temple subsequently
